The total highest-bidding amount made from the AEA joint auction held on the “first” “Tuesday” of every month, starting at “3” p.m. was around NTD 857,470,000.

Due to the stable condition of the epidemic, the government relaxed the epidemic control measures, and all AEA branches held the national joint auction on the “first” “Tuesday” of every month, starting at “3” p.m. on November 2, 2021 to provide various items for the public to bid on. There were multiple real properties auctioned in this joint auction, and broke the record of the total amount made from the highest-bidding of an auction. The total amount made from the highest-bidding was NTD 857,478,548, and will be collected by the treasury.

The total amount made from the highest-bidding amount of the real properties was NTD 854,764,017. The one with the highest-bidding price was the auction of 211 lands and 6 buildings of a Hsinchu golf course, auctioned by the Hsinchu Branch. The total amount made from its highest-bidding was NTD 761,540,000. There were 4 people participating in this auction. Due to the rarity and high base offering price of the subject, it was hard to find the participant to bid. There was also a 4-floor house located at Daxi Dist., Taoyuan City is auctioned with the highest-bidding amount of NTD 9,299,900. The highest-bidding amount made from the auction of the land located in Shilin District and auctioned by the Shilin Branch was NTD 5,400,000, and the highest-bidding amount made from the auction of 12 lands located in Nangang District and auctioned by the Shilin Branch was NTD 4,287,000. The highest-bidding amount made from the auction of 8 lands used for construction located in Yonghe District and auctioned by the New Taipei Branch was NTD 5,308,888. The highest-bidding amount made from the auction of the land located in Xiluo Township,

Yunlin County and auctioned by the Chiayi Branch was NTD 5,168,888. 臺 The highest-bidding amount made from the auction of the basement and its land located in Beitun District, Taichung City and auctioned by the Taichung Branch was NTD 4,028,888. The highest-bidding amount made from the auction of an apartment and its land located in Yongkang District, Tainan City and auctioned by the Tainan Branch was NTD 3,661,688. The highest-bidding amount made from the auction of a land for graveyard use located in Hualien City and auctioned by the Hualien Branch was NTD 1,910,000. Other branches also auctioned various real properties in good conditions and ended the conclusion of the auction with exceptional results.

The total amount made from the highest-bidding amount of the personal properties was NTD 2,714,531. The most eye-catching item is the double-sided Golden Dragon Painting made with silk tapestry and auctioned by the Shilin Branch. The amount made from its highest-bidding amount was NTD 240,000. The one with the highest-bidding amount was a 2013 BENZ sedan auctioned by the Kaohsiung Branch. The amount made from its highest-bidding was NTD 675,000. In addition, Changhua Prosecution Office entrusted the Changhua Branch to auction 5,383 boxes of masks. The amount made from its highest-bidding amount was NTD 107,660. Other personal properties auctioned included golf clubs, jade ornaments, notebooks, phone accessories, wooden furniture, pet groceries, ceramic cup set, Kitty aprons, stocks etc.

AEA reminds the public that though the epidemic has slowed down recently, everyone shall follow the relevant epidemic prevention measures implemented by CECC consistently to prevent any breach in epidemic prevention. All branches will also provide safe auction venues in compliance with the epidemic prevention regulations to let the public participate in the auction safely. AEA joint auction will be held on the “first” “Tuesday” of every month, starting at “3” p.m., the public may inquire about relevant information on its official website, or check the posts on the fan page for each branch.
